Entries Invited for 2022 Ace of Prints

As we have throughout the Pandemic, and in order to encourage your club to enter, we're setting the entry fee as £0 – i.e. nothing! – we need to encourage a return to printing once again.

Closing date is 19th June 2022 when the entry form for Round 1 must be in my possession – the prints can be brought on the morning of the competition which will be 3rd July 2022 at the Talbot Green Community Centre – doors open at 9.00am.

Two rounds 12 prints in the first round, 15 prints in the second round – you can bring as many prints as you can carry for your 2nd round choice! If there are enough Clubs entered, we will run a Plate Competition. The two top Clubs overall will be invited to represent the WPF at the Annual PAGB Club Print competition in October.

I'm looking forward to seeing you all there and to witnessing a feast of prints!
