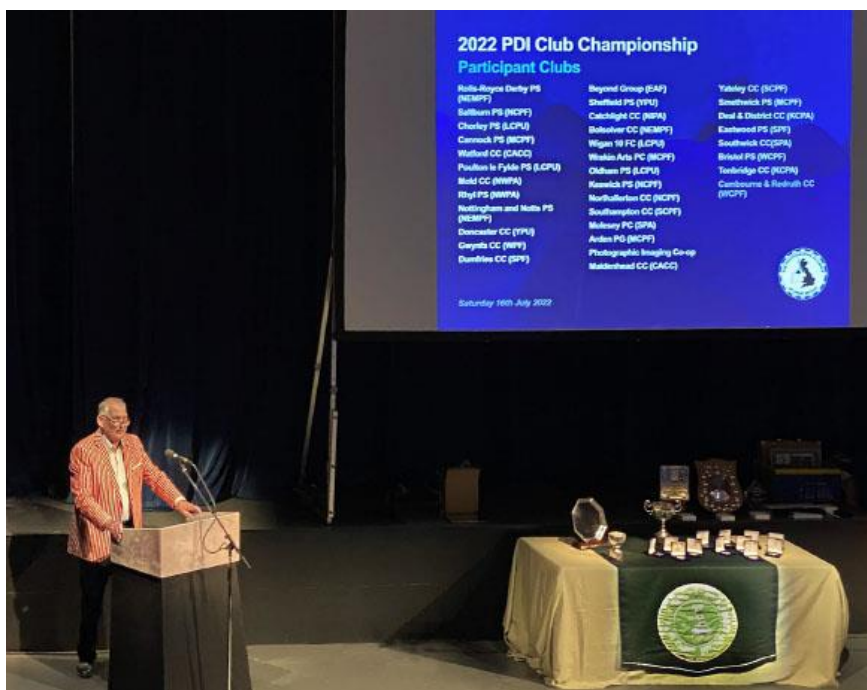
## Tenby & Gwynfa represent the WPF at Warwick

Well done to Tenby and Gwynfa who made the journey to Warwick to represent the WPF in the National Inter-Club PDI Championships.

In the WPF grudge match, Tenby finished the Plate competition in joint 5<sup>th</sup> (15<sup>th</sup> overall) place on 103 points and Gwynfa just two points behind in joint 10<sup>th</sup> place (20<sup>th</sup> overall).

Of the North Wales clubs, Mold finished joint 15<sup>th</sup> (25<sup>th</sup> overall) and Rhyl joint 22<sup>nd</sup> (32<sup>nd</sup> overall)

The winners of the event were Rolls Royce Dery & Wigan 10 who shared the title. Thirty five clubs competed in the event, representing all the UK photographic federations. A full report can be seen in [this edition of PAGB News](#).

Various analogue items belonging to a deceased photographer, far more than are listed below:

- **Sinar F2** – 5”x 4” monorail camera in sturdy wooden box, together with Schneider Super-Angulon 90mm f/8; 150mm Schneider; and Rodenstock Sironar-N 210mm f/5.6 lenses.
- **5” x 4” wooden field camera** – with 150mm lens. The make wasn’t identifiable to me but it is in good condition.
- **Hasselblad 500C/M** camera body with Prism Finder and Waist Level Finder. Lenses are Carl Zeiss Distagon 60mm f/3.5; Sonnar 150mm f/4; and Carl Zeiss Planar 80mm f/2.8.
- **Fujica ST705** 35mm camera body
- **Rolleiflex SL35** – 35mm camera with 50mm f/1.8, 35mm and 135mm Carl Zeiss lenses
- **Iford Sportsman** – 35mm camera probably dating back to the 1950’s
- **Microflex TLR** – medium format twin lens reflex camera with 77.5mm f/3.5 lens. Lens hood and various filters
- **Studio flash** – various lights, brollies, stands etc.
- **Gnome enlarger** – needs some work
- **BerkeyOmega D5500 with fitted Ilfospeed Multigrade 500 System** – this has a 6 x 6 negative carrier and there are 35mm inserts. I didn’t find a 5” x 4” negative carrier but, in view of the stock of cameras, there must be one.
- **Enlarger Print Easels** – various makes and sizes
- **Print drier** – for RC paper. It appeared to be large enough for 16” x 12” but would certainly dry 10” x 8”

There were a lot more things that one would expect to find in a well-stocked darkroom; far too much for me to list.
